This Airstream/Argosy Serial Number Decoder supersedes all previously published decoders. It was created using the combined resources and knowledge of Airstream, Inc. and the Wally Byam Caravan Club International (WBCCI, a.k.a. "The Airstream Club").

Notes:

- 1. This information is provided only because it may be of historical interest to Airstream enthusiasts. This information may contain errors and omissions, and it may not apply. The particulars of any specific Airstream product may vary from the information presented here. Accordingly, this is information is provided as is, without any warranty of any kind, and may contain errors or omissions.
- 2. The years 1958 and prior are not included because Airstream production records for those years are incomplete and research is ongoing. Those years may be added in the future.
- 3. The years 1981 and after are not included because serial numbers adhered to the government mandated 17-digit Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) system. A separate document addresses those years.
- 4. The attached pages provide general information regarding serial number formats, lengths, and model names. Production exceptions are not documented if they only affected one or two trailers, such as a missing character in a serial number or a prototype of a new model built late in the model year prior to the formal introduction of the model.
- 5. For years in which the model year was not encoded as a character in the serial number, the starting and ending production sequence numbers are provided for each length and model.
- 6. Within documented serial number ranges, occasionally a serial number was skipped and never produced, generally because an order was cancelled before production of the unit began.
- 7. In the following pages, characters shown within brackets (e.g. "(I)", "(J,S)", "(A,B,T,D)", etc.) in serial number formats may be:
 - a. "Optional" and thus may or may not be present in any given serial number.
 - b. An "either/or" situation where exactly one of the contained choices would be present.
 - c. Occasionally both "optional" and "either/or".

Notes: It is currently believed that all 1960 commercial trailers had riveted aluminum endcaps and normal Airstream serial number badges like regular production Airstreams, though as a cost savings measure these trailers tended to use older, less expensive windows.

Most, if not all, commercial trailers from 1961 thru 1964 did not look like regular production Airstreams, instead having a slightly "squarer" appearance with fiberglass exterior endcaps that were painted silver and subtle ribbing down the sides of the trailer. These trailers had Mobile Industrial serial number badges that listed the street address of the Santa Fe Springs Airstream plant.

Generally, commercial trailers 32' and longer were made as mobile housing for railroad crews with living/bedrooms on both ends and kitchens and bathrooms in the middle. The intended purpose of the 20' to 28' units is unknown.
