Key Points

- **Towing Efficiency:** Every Airstream travel trailer features an aerodynamic profile that improves fuel efficiency and handling. But our single-axle trailers are especially nimble and can be easily towed by mid-sized trucks and SUVs.
- **Handmade Construction:** Like all our travel trailers, the holding tanks in our single-axle trailers are built into the chassis – putting more than half the total weight of the trailer below the floor line – resulting in a lower stance and improved stability while towing.
- **Space Efficiency:** Our smaller trailers offer all the comforts you find in larger trailers, with especially space-efficient floor plans that maximize storage. They’re particularly great for weekend excursions but can handle longer trips too. And all but the Basecamp 16 offer secondary sleeping areas so you can bring along the family.
- **Modern Conveniences:** The standard 12V refrigerators and optional microwaves, air conditioning, and lithium and solar packages mean you can tailor your single-axle Airstream to your camping and traveling needs while bringing along all the comfort you desire.

Bambi Key Points

- Bambi and Caravel share three identical floor plans in 16, 20, and 22 feet, with major differences in décor, materials, surfaces, finishes, and exterior features. Bambi models all feature panoramic windows up front that wrap around the dinette in the 16-foot model, and spacious beds in the two larger floor plans.
- Note the differences in bathrooms: An efficient wet bath (16RB) or a wide bathroom across the rear of the trailer (20FB and 22FB).
- Each model has a convertible dinette for extra sleeping space, but the two larger trailers locate that space in the midship. Galley sinks expand to double well in larger models and the twenty foot Bambi has the most counter space, making it ideal for mobile chefs.

Caravel Key Points

- While Caravel shares three identical floor plans with Bambi, this upscale model line takes modern style and premium materials to the next level. Though the layouts are the same, surfaces, fixtures, window blinds, upholstery, and many exterior features are different. Caravel was designed for both short excursions and longer trips, with larger cabinets, rear bumper storage, and “Nev-r-Lube” bearings.
- The Bambi 16RB and Caravel 16RB both have panoramic windows surrounding the front dinette, but in Caravel the rear also features a panoramic window (where Bambi’s is a single rectangular window) for gorgeous views upon waking up.

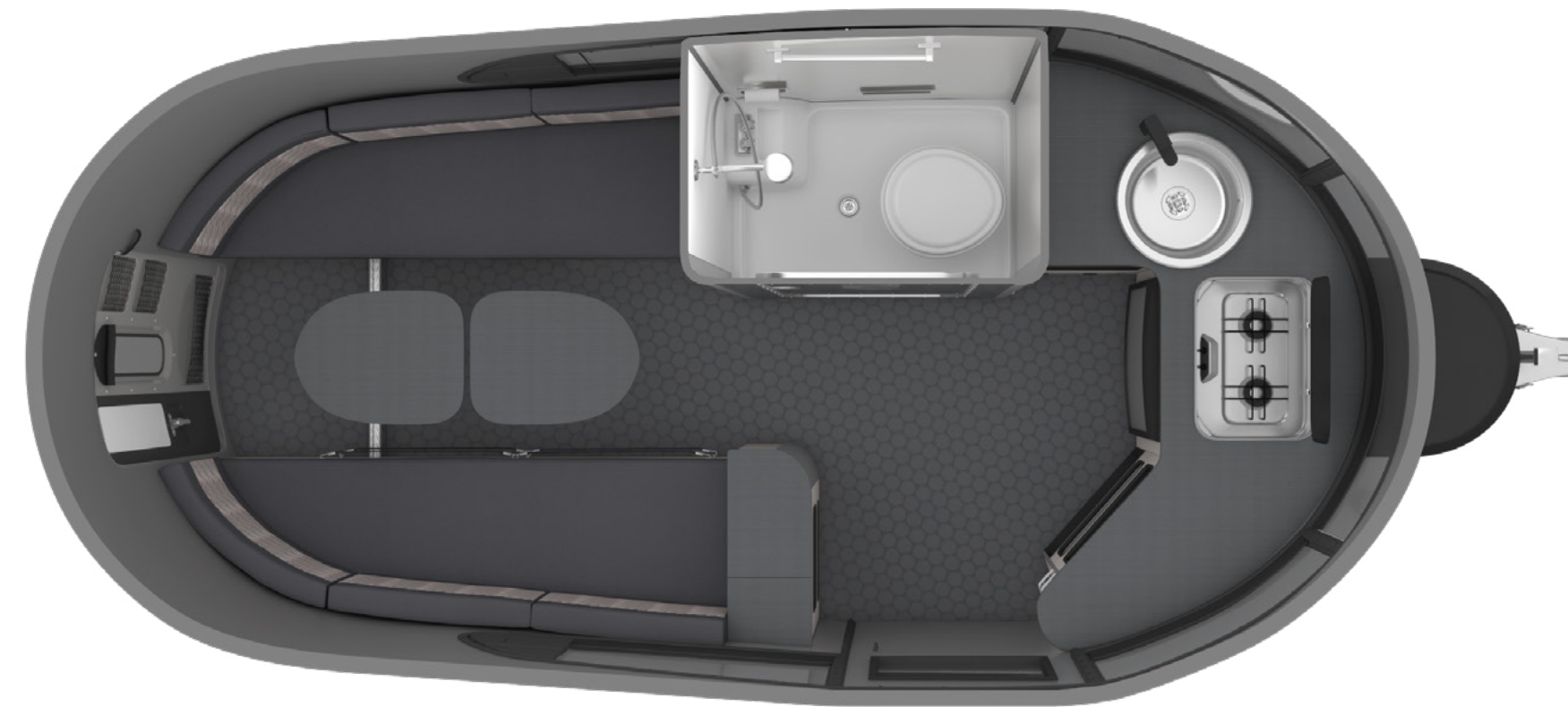
Basecamp Key Points

- Basecamp offers four different models to choose from: Basecamp 16, Basecamp 20, the REI Co-op Special Edition (16- and 20-foot), and Basecamp 20Xe. Floor plans are shared across 16-foot models and 20-foot models. Twenty-foot models have a galley in the midship across from the wet bath.
- Note additional storage areas adjacent to the wet bath in Basecamp 20 and the swiveling tabletop in the 20-foot model's convertible dinette, which makes it easy to slip in and out without disturbing others. The rear seating/sleeping area in both floor plans can be converted to a wide variety of setups to tailor it to your travel needs.
- Twenty-foot models feature two convertible dining/living/sleeping areas. Many owners utilize the back area for dedicated sleeping and use the front dinette for eating, working, and lounging.
- Add even more off-grid functionality with the optional X-Package, available for both Basecamp 16 and Basecamp 20. Featuring stainless steel front stone guards and front solar guards, a 3-inch lift for navigating challenging terrain, rugged tires, and more, the X-Package is designed for getting even farther afield. The X-Package comes standard in REI Co-op Special Edition and Basecamp 20Xe models.

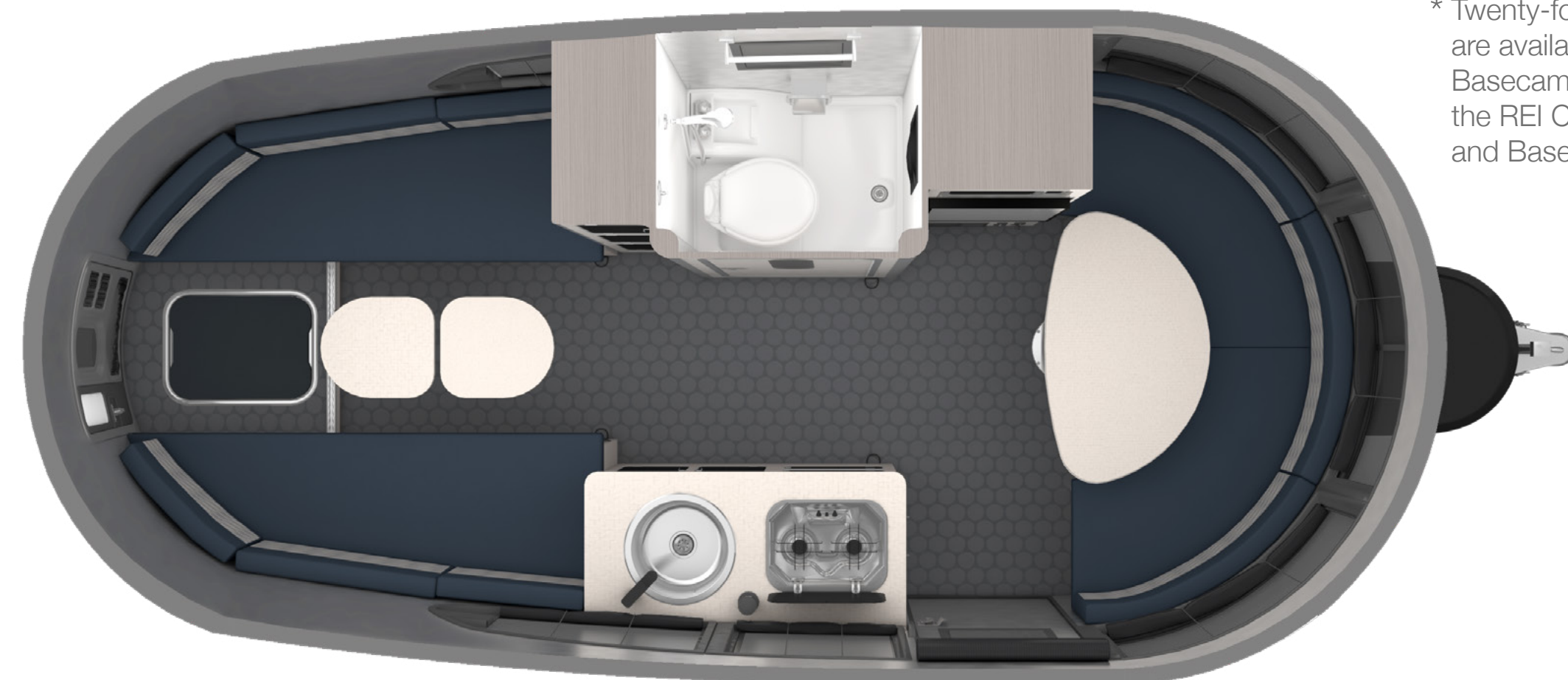
